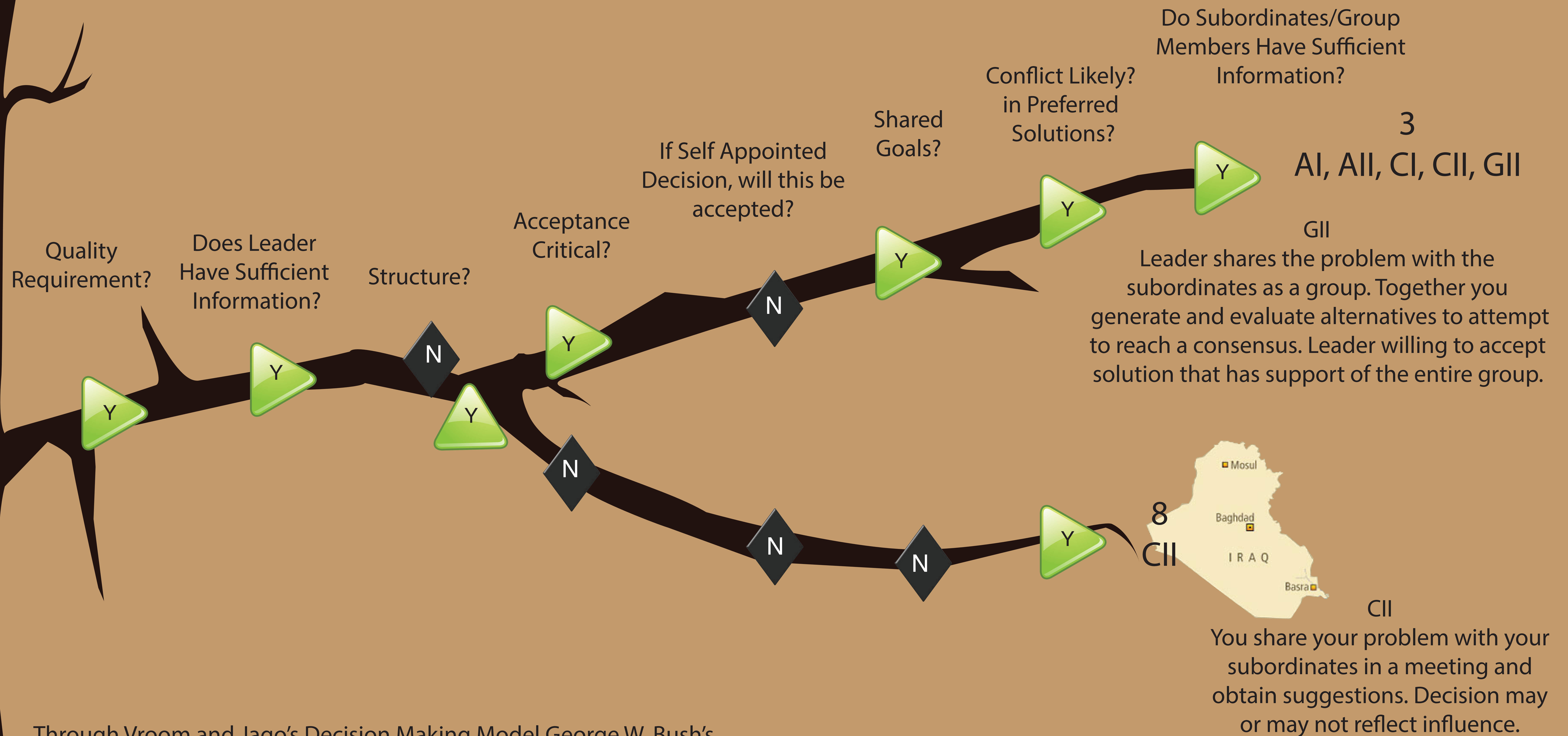


# A Normative Model of Decision Processes



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Through Vroom and Jago's Decision Making Model George W.
